



Face-2-Face Befriender Training - Shoreham

Are you a parent-carer? Would you like to be part of an exciting new project? Would you like to take up a valuable and fulfilling role as a Face-2-Face befriender?

Following the success of our Face-2-Face befriending project in Worthing and Crawley, Reaching Families are pleased to announce a new training course for befrienders in Shoreham. Face-2-Face is for parents of children with SEND in West Sussex who are undergoing or have recently undergone diagnosis. The project works by matching parent-carers with an experienced volunteer befriender who will provide emotional and practical support to help them on their journey.

Our 7 week training course covers a range of vital skills and knowledge essential to being a befriender including active listening, verbal and non-verbal communication, confidentiality and self-disclosure, empathy, developing resilience and personal boundaries. At the end of the course we will carry out a further safeguarding training session and DBS check and then begin matching you with a local parent-carer who will benefit from your knowledge, skills and experience.

We are flexible as to how much time you can support a family—some may prefer weekly meetings, others less frequently.
